Countdown Continues for 2026 Control Line World Championships

Preparations for the 2026 Control Line World Championships continue to gather pace, with organisers confirming the event is now entering its final planning stages.

Event organiser Trevor Letchford said work is progressing well and many of the major elements are now either complete or close to finalised.

“Preparations are continuing and nearly finalised,” Trevor said. “We’ve opened entries and the preliminary response has been as good as my best hopes.”

With competitor interest already strong, the focus has now shifted to counting down to the championship itself. Organisers are expecting a substantial international field, building on the success and reputation established at previous Australian-hosted world championships.

MAAA members are strongly encouraged to attend if they are able. Those planning to travel to Western Australia—either as competitors, supporters or volunteers—are invited to contact Trevor directly to receive a support pack and event information.

The end-of-event banquet, to be held on the final night of the championship, will celebrate the conclusion of the World Championships and acknowledge competitors, officials and volunteers. Tickets for the banquet must be booked in advance and will not be available on the night.

With entries now open and enthusiasm building both locally and internationally, the 2026 Control Line World Championships are shaping up to be a standout event on the global aeromodelling calendar.
